Students bring rich and diverse backgrounds to the classroom! A classroom with access to technology has the potential to broaden students' worldviews and inspire future change agents. But in this time of open access, it is extremely important that our classrooms reflect equity and respect diversity. For educators, there is a responsibility to be mindful of bias in the classroom. This course will help participants to create lessons that are inclusive for all learners. We will bring a critical lens to our own teaching practice and make the necessary instructional shifts towards anti-bias practices. The art of designing and delivering instruction is very exciting, but one must always keep the students in their class at the heart of their design.

This course will be conducted in an asynchronous online setting utilizing Google Classroom as the delivery platform. Participants meet virtually via online communities to discuss and share lessons and strategies. Personal Google accounts will be required to access the course.

Participants will learn to:

- Build awareness of culture and Culturally Responsive Education and the relevance it plays in schools aiming for equity.
- Support the examination of personal identity and that of students to oppose individual, institutional, and cultural racism.
- Bring preconceived notions & bias to the surface to understand how biases impact beliefs, practices, and policies.
- Demonstrate how SEL can promote educational equity by helping all young people reach their fullest potential.
- Understand and recognize microaggressions and how they affect students.
- Explore digital resources and tools to support a culturally responsive classroom.
